The 12-hour Intensive covers advanced breathing practices and the Level I forms with two focuses: First, how to enter into the "Qigong state" by integrating body and mind with the breath, and second, how to practice with correct posture, alignment and energy flow. Day 1 will begin with **Breath Empowerment** to jump start your practice and fill the body with oxygen; Day 2 will end with the **Nine Breath Meditation Circle**, a powerful practice to channel the group energy to healing others.

Students wishing to deepen their practice, or pursue certification as Supreme Science Qigong Instructors (Level I) should commit to a daily 40-minute Qigong practice with the Level I DVD* and attend the two-part Qigong Healing Instructor Trainings on August 7 & 28, 2011.
